Embroidered Mug Rug / Snack Mat / Coaster

Make a cute and useful mug rug, snack mat, or coaster with your choices of fabric and embroidery designs. Let your creative juices flow as you create a one-of-a-kind item for yourself or someone close to you. This hands-on class is a great opportunity for beginning embroiderers and seasoned stitchers alike!



Supplies Needed

Fabrics:

First you need to decide whether you'll be making a mug rug, snack mat, or coaster. Your choice of fabrics will depend on the design(s) you've chosen to make. Let me know if you would like me to resend the list of Embroidery Sites. In most cases, fat quarters and fabric scraps should be sufficient to complete any of the three project choices.

Stabilizers:

- 1 piece of fusible fleece or low loft batting, the size required for your project. ✓
- Small scraps or pieces of Floriani Medium Tearaway to use if your project has dense stitching which would be better supported with the addition of floating some pieces of tearaway stabilizer under the design. ✓

Notions:

- Lite Steam-a-Seam 2 for closing the back opening if needed. ✓
- Embroidery needle size 75/11. ✓
- Temporary marking pen. ✓
- 6-inch seam gauge or small ruler. ✓
- Embroidery threads to coordinate with your design choices, as many as your design(s) require. ✓
- 2 different bobbins, depending on your color choices for the mug rug/snack mat/coaster:
 1. One bobbin with basic embroidery bobbin thread or use a pre-wound for embroidering your project design. ✓
 2. One bobbin wound for matching bottom and top embroidery thread **if** your project uses a satin-stitch edge finish. ✓
- In-the-Hoop Applique Scissors for trimming appliqué if your embroidery design has any applique; embroidery scissors for trimming threads; scissors for trimming away stabilizer, if needed. ✓
- Temporary adhesive spray and/or embroidery tape. ✓

Machine & Accessories:

- Embroidery/sewing machine in good working order with manual, power cord, embroidery foot, and regular sewing foot or walking foot. ✓
- Hoops: Whichever size hoop(s) you are able (or want) to use for creating an ITH (In the Hoop) mug rug/snack mat/coaster project. ✓
- Normal sewing supplies such as straight pins, hand sewing needles, seam ripper, etc. ✓
- USB Stick to transfer embroidery designs to your machine, if needed. ✓
