A great project for medium and large scale prints. Choose fabrics that blend together. Avoid high contrast solid fabrics. The patchwork is sewn without planning. Then follow the clever cutting layout for a figure flattering jacket with vertical and horizontal strips.

Do not preshrink outside fabric, however preshrink flannel lining or smooth cotton, if desired. Jacket does not use batting. When finished piecing and attaching to the lining, you will wash, dry (and shrink) the patchwork to give it that soft look of an old quilt. Then we cut out the jacket using the pattern.

YARDAGE

Spontaneous Strip Pieced Patchwork

½ yd. each of nine cotton fabrics.

½ yd. cotton fabric (contrasting) for collar, cuffs and button loops.

3 yds. of silky cotton/poly mix lining fabric, lightweight cotton or flannel.

¾ yd. fusible interfacing.

Covered Raglan Shoulder Pads

3 buttons, 1 and ¼" wide

Safety Pins ✓

Gentle Soap

Rotary Cutter, Cutting Ruler and Mat ✓

Sewing Machine in good working order AND Walking Foot ✓
