Supplies Needed

OESD design 12765-05 and 12765-29. These designs can be purchased at [Embroidery Design Studio](#) or click on the  on the DSC website to get to the Embroidery Design Studio website.

Fabric & Such:

- 1/8 yd white cotton center front
- 1/2 yd gray cotton for the front
- 1/2 yd cotton for the back
- 1/2 yd batting

Thread:

- 1 spool of Silver Metallic thread ✓
- 1 spool red embroidery thread ✓

Needles, Notions & Stabilizer:

- Size 80 or 90 Microtex needles ✓
- 2 Floriani template sheets printed ✓
- Tear away stabilizer ✓
- 1 1/4 yd Shape Flex Fusible Stabilizer ✓
- Spiral Card Holders (sample used 14) ✓
- General sewing supplies ✓



Machine & Accessories:

- Embroidery machine in good working condition with manual and 5 x 7 hoop ✓

✓ Denotes items available for purchase at Dublin Sewing Center. These items should always be purchased at Dublin Sewing Center to ensure that you have the correct product and to ensure that we can continue to teach these Classes at a low price. Please remember, though, that we only carry a few of each item at a time so it is best to purchase your items prior to the class (in person or by phone).

Pre-Class Preparation:

Cutting:

- 1 piece 3" x WOF (width of fabric) of white cotton
- 2 pieces 7" x WOF of grey
- 1 piece 13" x WOF for the back
- 1 piece 13" x 40" batting
- 3 pieces 2 1/2" x WOF binding
- Shape Flex fusible pieced to fit the (1) piece of white and the (2) pieces of grey fabric

Apply the Shape Flex to the wrong side according to the manufacturer's directions. Sew the 2 grey pieces of cotton fabric to the middle white strip using 1/4" seam. Press the seams to the grey fabric. The embroidery is time consuming and completing this will help us finish the project in class.
