The Tiffany is a chic satchel bag, perfect for everyday style! This pattern has been cleverly designed to avoid using any bias binding. Instead, you will learn how to add a drop-in lining. The name of this pattern was inspired by the classic movie, Breakfast at Tiffany's.

FEATURES: adjustable crossbody strap, handles, an exterior slip pocket, wide opening top with luggage style zipper closure, and is fully lined.

FINISHED SIZE: 10" wide, 9" high, and 5" deep



Supplies Needed

- Tiffany Pattern and Kit - *Note: this kit comes with antique brass hardware and includes a zipper with black tape and antique brass pulls.* (this kit includes the bag pattern and all of the hardware you will need to complete the bag - **must be ordered in advance**) ✓
- Recommended fabrics:
 - Exterior - quilt weight cotton, canvas, denim, or linen.
 - Lining & Pockets - Quilt weight cotton or linen is recommended for the lining. **For more stable pockets, I recommend applying a fusible woven interfacing to all of the lining and pocket pieces.**
 - Contrast - Cork fabric, faux leather or any fabric that does not fray
- Material requirements:
 - Exterior - Exterior, slip pocket and strap connectors 1/2 Yard (42" wide) non directional or 5/8 yard directional
 - Lining - 1/2 yard (42" wide). I recommend applying Fusible Woven Interfacing (SF101/Shapeflex) to all of these pieces.
 - Contrast 1/3 yard (27" wide) or 11" (54" wide)
 - Sew-In Foam (Soft and Stable) - 1/3 yard (58" wide) or 3/4 yard (20" wide) ✓
 - **Optional Hardware** - Rivets, personalized bag label
- Notions and other supplies
 - Sewing machine in good working order, with accessories and manual ✓
 - Zipper foot to fit your sewing machine ✓
 - 1/4" foot to fit your sewing machine (optional but recommended) ✓
 - Fabric scissors ✓
 - Pins ✓
 - Wonder clips ✓
 - Seam Ripper ✓
 - Thread to match your fabric ✓
 - Fabric marker ✓
 - Metal stiletto (optional, but recommended) ✓
 - 1/4" Double sided basting tape (i.e. Wonder Tape) ✓
 - Temporary Spray Adhesive ✓
 - Awl or rotary punch to punch out screw holes ✓

Pre-class Preparation:

Copy and cut out all paper pattern pieces, found on pages 7-8. Follow the instructions on each pattern piece. Then, measure and cut the following pieces listed below.

EXTERIOR

- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 11-1/4" piece for **Front**
- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 11-1/4" piece for **Back**
- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 18-1/2" piece for **Slip Pocket**
- Cut (1) 1-1/2" by 5" piece for **Strap Connectors**

LINING

- Cut (2) 10-3/4" by 11-1/4" pieces for **Lining**
- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 5" piece for **Bottom**

CONTRAST

- Cut (2) 1-1/2" by WOF (or (1) if your contrast is 54" wide) strips for **Crossbody Strap**
- Cut (2) 1-1/2" by 20" strips for **Handles**
- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 5-1/4" piece for **Bottom**

FOAM

- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 11-1/4" piece for **Front**
- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 11-1/4" piece for **Back**
- Cut (1) 10-3/4" by 5-1/4" piece for **Bottom**
- Cut (1) 16" by 8" piece for **Upper Side Panels**
- Cut (1) 8" by 6" piece for **Lower side Panels**

Following steps 1 through 3 on page 1 of the instructions, attach the foam to the coordinating pieces.

Bring your extra fabric and interfacing to class in case you need to cut any additional pieces.
