Supplies Needed

- Heart's Choice Quilt Pattern (pre-order pattern by January 11, 2018) ✓
- Fabric & Such **(Please see pre-class preparation instructions below)**

For the fabrics, I used scraps from my stash. I chose to make Border #3 in various widths so that I could use up some narrow pieces that blended well. If you need to buy fabrics, use the following guide:

- Four assorted fabrics — 1/4 yard each
 - Top of large hearts, 4 small hearts
 - Accent color --Border #1, 4 corner squares (hot pink in my sample)
 - Binding (deep sky blue in my sample)
 - Background material (white in my sample)
- 14 assorted fabrics – 1/8 yard each
 - To be used in strip piecing and assorted fabrics in Border #3.
- Batting -- 26 inches x 26 inches ✓
- Back of Quilt – 26 inches x 26 inches (white in my sample)
- Machine & Accessories
 - Sewing machine in good working order with manual and accessories ✓
 - Basic sewing supplies (scissors, thread, pins, clips, thread, etc.) ✓
 - Standard presser foot ✓
 - Piecing foot (for a scant 1/4 inch seam allowance) ✓
 - Piping foot (if you want piping along your finished binding) ✓
 - Scissors ✓
 - Rotary cutter ✓
 - Ruler for rotary cutter ✓
 - Small mat for cutting (ideal if it is cutting on one side, and ironing on the other) ✓
 - Piping hot binding kit (or similar piping tool—again, optional if you want piping) ✓
- Steam a Seam 2 (one sheet) ✓
- Iron and pressing board (optional—we will need it a lot, but you can share) ✓

✓ Denotes items available for purchase at Dublin Sewing Center. These items should always be purchased at Dublin Sewing Center to ensure that you have the correct product and to ensure that we can continue to teach these Clubs at a low price. Please remember, though, that we only carry a few of each item at a time so it is best to purchase your items prior to the class (in person or by phone).

Pre-Class Cutting directions:

Please be sure to cut all your fabric before class. You won't want to take the time in class to cut it!

From the background fabric (white in my sample), cut:

5 squares—5 ½" x 5 ½"

2 squares—5 7/8" x 5 7/8"—Cut these in half diagonally

2 strips—2" x wof (width of fabric) for border # 2

1 square—26" x 26" (for the back of the wall hanging—you may choose a different fabric)

From the accent color (hot pink in my sample), cut:

2 strips -- 1 1/8" x wof (for border # 1)

4 squares -- 2 ½" x 2 ½" (for the corner squares of border 3)

From 14 strips, cut: 1 each color:

1 7/8" x 13"

(Or you may cut these of varying widths from 1 ½" to 2 ½", all 13" in length.)

If you have time, sew the strips together to form a rectangle about 19 ½" (or more) x 13". We will cut these in class to form our 4 border pieces for border #3.

From the 14 strips, also cut:

1" x wof each color (for the striped material)

If you are using scraps, the length of the cuts can vary from 2" to 10".

You may repeat colors if you want.

Bring your scraps with you in case you need to cut a few more in class.
