You will have directions for yardage amounts, cutting directions, and a planning sheet if you want to visualize that colors and fabrics go where to achieve the perfect finished look you desire. In Class -We will do Step 3 thru 5 (including Fig.12, Fig.13, Fig. 14) Do Step 6 – (up to Fig. 18) We will complete from Fig. 19 to end, in class

Cargo Bag and Pin Pod we will review assembly in class.
