

Supply List:

These are the basic tools and equipment you should bring to an embroidery class. On occasion you will need to put your machine in “sewing” mode so I have listed those items as well. It is helpful to have an assortment of hoops to work with too. Usually you will need a 5” x 7” hoop and the next size larger, such as 6” x 10” or 7” x 12” depending on your machine.

Please label your equipment and supplies with your name. Lots of us have the same tools and I want you to go home with everything you brought to class. Make a label with name on a piece of tape or ribbon to put on your power cord and foot control. If you inadvertently forget them we can give you a call. Tie a ribbon around your scissors, be creative!

Embroidery machine with 7 x 12 or larger hoop, embroidery module and embroidery accessory kit. Remember your power cord AND your foot control AND your thread stand! Please have your embroidery foot attached as well. Also bring your box of machine accessories. You might need the screwdriver or some other tool. Also, bring your machine manual in case we need help with those advanced functions!

Multipurpose sewing foot, walking foot, zipper foot and ¼" foot for sewing mode

75/11 and 90/14 embroidery needles

USB stick to load embroidery designs on your machine
