## Supplies:

- ✓ Freezer paper. Best to bring a box.
- ✓ Drafting or blue low stick tape.
- ✓ Extra fine sharpie, pencil
- ✓ Colored pencils. Any type will do. Variety is what we're after. Pencil sharpener.
- ✓ Iron and ironing pad
- ✓ Sewing machine in good working order
- ✓ Basic sewing supplies
  - o Pins
  - Paper and fabric scissors
  - o Seam ripper
- ✓ Rotary cutting supplies
- ✓ Fabrics:

You will be choosing fabrics based on how it will portray your desired image, (chair, tile, pot etc). I would feel safe bringing ¾ - 1 yard each of your fabrics designated for the Adirondack chair and the tile. Make sure you bring lights, mediums and darks for the chair to create a dimensional look. I was able to create the chair out of two fabrics. Of course you may not use it all but if you have a directional piece or a piece which may need to be cut all over the place to achieve your desired effect, you will need it. There is no science in estimating fabrics for a pictorial piece and more often than not, you will need more, not less.

Aside from the tile and chair, which require the most yardages, you will need fabrics for the following:

- ✓ Pots and rim of pots and dark or medium dark for inside pots.
- ✓ Paint cans and lids. Make sure the fabric you choose shows up well on your tile fabric. I scrapped these out.
- ✓ Grout for tile, about 1/3 yard.
- ✓ Paint stick, paint brush, scraps.
- ✓ Foliage, scraps of leaf color fabrics.
- ✓ Background, behind pot and chair, approximately 1/3 yard. I used two fabrics to indicate foliage in these areas.

Of course this is your art piece and these requirements are based on what I used. You may change any of these areas based on how you see this piece. Remember, it is best to bring more fabrics so you can audition them. Make certain you have a variety of lights, mediums and darks which are necessary to create depth and shadow.
