This monthly Block of the Month program gives you the opportunity to learn about and utilize your sewing machine and feet to the **max!** You will learn new techniques for applique and how to apply all those fabulous decorative stitches on your machine!! You will also learn techniques such as **pintucking, bobbinwork, and couching**. Join us for this unique learning experience!

Supply List:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Owners' Manual for your sewing machine
- Bring all feet and accessories (no machine embroidery in this class, so no embroidery modules needed)
- Machine Needles: For piecing and applique (We will also use double needles, wing needles, and topstitch needles for various blocks)
- Machine ¼" foot, open-toe foot and cording foot to name a few
- Fusible Web (we have "Stick N' Fuse II" by Inspira)
- Thread for piecing and decorative stitching Threads, i.e. embroidery and yummy specialty threads
- Scissors, small for paper, Rotary Cutter, Paper and Pencil
- Spray Starch (recommend Mary Ellen's)
- 12 ½" Quilt Ruler
- Teflon Applique Pressing Sheet
- Air Soluble Marker or fine point disappearing ink pen
- Template Plastic
- Optional Batting for adding depth to squares
- Stabilizer, we will discuss in class different types
