Class Description:

Learn the basics of Machine Embroidery in this 2-part class.

Morning Session: Explore importing an embroidery design from an external source into your machine, choosing stabilizers, hooping, and basic embroidery techniques while making a mug rug.

Afternoon Session: Embroidery on a towel.

Supplies: *Bring the following to class or purchase at Quilter's Corner with your 10% class discount:*

- \$25 Kit – includes USB with embroidery designs, fabrics, stabilizers, towel.
- Embroidery machine in good working order
- Embroidery Arm and power cord
- 5x7 hoop or larger
- Embroidery Threads:
 - Session 1 – pink, green, and white
 - Session 2 – Color you would like to use for a monogram (monogram font will be provided or you may choose one from your machine)
- Filled bobbins – white bobbin thread, either Bottom Line or Brother bobbin thread
- Applique trimming scissors

Preparation for Class:

- Plan to arrive 15 minutes early for set-up.
