Prerequisite Skills: Basic sewing skills

Required Materials: (Available at Peak to Peak™ Stitching; 10% discount for class materials)

- Sewing machine in good running condition with power cord, pedal and owner's manual - be familiar with how to use it!
- Open toe or applique foot that fits your machine (NOT blind hem foot)
- Stiletto or trolley needle
- Both paper and fabric scissors
- Empty bobbin
- Straight pins for applique
- Thread snips
- Pencil
- Basic sewing tools, scissors or snips, seam ripper, bobbins, pins

Optional Materials:

- Travel size iron
- Travel size pressing mat
- Tweezers (very helpful)

Cancellation Policy:

Easy, Turned-Edge Machine Appliqué

This easy pattern is uniquely designed to teach my turned-edge, layered, nearly-invisible machine-appliqué technique using freezer paper templates, liquid starch and nylon invisible thread. Students need to have a sewing machine with 'adjustable blind-hem stitch' capability.

STUDENT SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Sewing machine with blind-hem stitch adjustment capability — Please bring the instruction manual for your machine!
- Extension table (very helpful!)
- Open toe or applique foot (see example below, NOT blind-hem foot)



- Paper scissors and fabric scissors
- Travel-size iron (If you don't have one, don't worry.)
- Empty bobbin
- Straight pins for applique
- Stiletto or trolley needle
- Tweezers (very helpful)
- Thread snips
- Pencil

Class registration fee includes kit! Pattern, freezer paper, pre-washed fabrics, machine needle, bobbin thread and YLI Wonder Invisible thread are all provided.
