

Pre-Class Cutting Guidance & Materials Needed

Pre-Class Cutting Guidance

Before class begins, take some time to start your cutting. There's no need to rush—spreading the work over a few days can make the process more enjoyable and less overwhelming.

As you cut, **bag and label each group of pieces** so everything stays organized and easy to access during class.

Refer to **Page 1 of the pattern** for the exact cutting instructions and quantities for each fabric.

Good preparation will help you make the most of your class time and allow you to jump right into sewing.

Curvy Log Cabin Pattern

- (5) 1/3 yard cuts assorted "lighter" fabrics for 'logs' (cream, lt. blue, lavender, black/white stripe, aqua)
- (4) 1 yard cuts assorted "lighter" fabrics for 'logs' and background (citrine, cheddar, gray, pink)
- (1) 1/4 yard for center of log cabin blocks (coral)
- (8) 2/3 yard cuts assorted "darker" fabrics for 'logs' (navy, teal, red, brown, green, dk green, dk plum, black)
- 5 yards for backing
- 2/3 yard binding
- Quick Curve Ruler (required)
- Sew Square 8 (required)

Materials

- Fabric scissors
- Zipper (slightly shorter than the pillow's final side length, e.g., 14-inch zipper for an 18-inch pillow)
- Pins
- Seam ripper
- Iron
- Cutting Mat
- Rotary cutter
- Thread (50 wt)
- Wool Mat for Ironing if you have one (I will bring mine to class)
- Zipper foot
- Sewing machine
- Bobbins
