Flower Placemat Class Supply List

In this class, you will create a **Flower-themed Placemat** while learning three quilting techniques:

- **Reverse appliqué**
- **Quilt-as-you-go technique**
- **Binding on alongarm machine**

These skills can be applied to larger projects like wall hangings or full-size quilts.

Fabric Requirements (please cut before class)

You will have three layers with three different colors for your reverse appliqué flower.

Fabric # 1	Description	Cut Size (inches)	Notes
1A	Light fabric (white, cream, tan, or newsprint)	7½ x 15	Layer 1
1B	Flower color	7½ x 15	Layer 2
1C	Green for stem and leaves	7½ x 15	Layer 3

For the strip piecing of the placement you can select coordinating fabrics for your Fabric 1 selection of the flower

Fabric #	Description	Cut Size (inches)	Notes
2	Coordinating fabric	3½ x 15	Strip piecing
3	Coordinating fabric	4½ x 15	Strip piecing
4	Coordinating fabric	2½ x 15	Strip piecing
5	Coordinating fabric	3½ x 15	Strip piecing
6	Pocket fabric	4½ x 11	Optional pocket
7	Binding (have ready to apply)	80 x 2¼	Precut binding strip
8	Backing	1 yard	Enough for 2 placemats

Additional Supplies

Batting: **43 x 20** (double the batting for firmer placemat)

- Sharp **appliqué scissors**
- **Thread** of choice for quilting
- **Two wound bobbins** (same thread as quilting)
- **6 x 6 ruler** (minimum)
