

Quilt 101 Supply List

Supply List

- Pattern: Silver Star from Villa Rosa Designs
- Fabric: As noted on the pattern
 - Kits are available at Quilt Mercantile which include the pattern to make the quilt like the class sample
 - If you are not comfortable picking fabrics – we can assemble a kit on your behalf or you can meet Pam at the shop prior to class to pick fabric - this should be done in advance of class (not the day of class)
- Thread for piecing: Gutermann cotton, recommended
- Marking Pen or Pencil: Frixion or Sewline, recommended
- Rulers:
 - Square Ruler – 7.5” or larger
 - Rectangle Ruler – 3 x 18” or larger
- Rotary Cutter: 45mm minimum, with new blade
- Cutting Mat: 12 x 18 or larger
- Pins: Clover Fine Piecing Pins, recommended
- Small Scissors or Snips: For snipping threads while sewing
- Seam Ripper: Just in case ☺
- Presser Foot: ¼” with seam guide recommended
- Bobbins: Wound with thread you will use for piecing
- Sharp Needles: Size 80/12
- Machine: Oiled, good working condition, cord, foot pedal, machine manual

Pam will guide you through all the steps to make this stunning star quilt, sharing tips and techniques for perfect points, precision piecing and flat borders. Students should have a general working knowledge of the machine they bring to class.
