CLASS SUPPLIES & PRE-CLASS CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric Requirements & Preparation

Before choosing your fabrics, review the **Sew Kind of Wonderful Double Rings** pattern to determine the quilt size you plan to make. The pattern includes detailed fabric requirements for each size.

The example provided in this handout follows the **Twin size** cutting plan.

To make the most of your class time, **please have all fabric cut, labeled, and ready to sew before class begins**. This preparation will allow you to jump right into learning the Quick Curve Ruler techniques and begin assembling your blocks right away.

CLASS SUPPLIES & PRE-CLASS CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

You will need to review the pattern to determine what size quilt you will make. The pattern gives you your fabric requirements based upon what size quilt you will make. Below is an example of the fabric based upon a Twin size quilt.

- Cut (30) 5" WOF assorted focus fabrics for rings and sashing triangles
 - Sub cut from each of focus fabrics 5" x WOF
 - (2) 4 ½ x 4 ½ squares (total 50 square)
- Cut each of the 4 ½ x 4 ½ squares in half diagonally (100) D triangles (only 96 will be used)
- (2) 2 ½ x 31 strips (total 50 Strips)
- (15) 1/3 yard cuts assorted neutral fabrics or (4 ¾ yards background fabric)
- (1) 2" WOF from strips subcut from each – (4) 10" x 10" (total 48 squares)
- Cut each in half diagonally (96) B Triangles
 - 2" x WOF from stripCut
 - (8) 2" x 2" (total 96 E Squares)
