

SCRAP CRAZY CLASS

Welcome to the Scrap Crazy Class. We will be using a custom created Accuquilt die to cut out this quilt. How big you want to make is up to you! You can use all scraps, use fat quarters or use controlled scraps. You can also sash and border to make as large as you like. You can only cut out ONE quilt in class.

During class, we will review various ways to set your blocks.

SUPPLIES

- Creative Grids Scrap Crazy 8 CGRT4 8" Ruler - Highly recommend purchasing in case you need to make more blocks at home.
- Fabric pieces 10.5" x 11.5". One piece will equal one block (8" **FINISHED**). So if you want a 56" (7 blocks wide) x 72" (9 blocks long) you would need 63 pieces of fabric.

For example:

- 56" x 72" - need 63 pieces of fabric (7 x 9 block set)
- 64" x 72" - need 72 pieces of fabric (8 x 9 block set)
- 64" x 80" - need 80 pieces of fabric (8 x 10 block set)
- Sashing and border fabric requirements are not included as there are many various ways you can select to sash or border or you may elect not to do either.
- Machine in working order
- Quilting thread
- Ironing surface and small iron
- 1/4" foot
- Small scissors
- 8.5" square (optional)

PREPARATION

- Cut your pieces into 10.5" x 11.5"
- Starch all fabrics
