

Quilted Sweatshirt Jacket RETREAT



Pam Patton will teach you how to make a sweatshirt jacket similar to the one pictured of your very own. Each jacket will be unique based on your color and pattern selections. The options are endless.

Supplies:

- Quilted Sweatshirt instruction sheet - \$5 payable to Pam at Retreat
- Assorted (larger) fabric scraps, FQ Bundle, Charm packs, Layer Cakes, Orphan Blocks in a coordinated color palette. You will want options so be generous in what you bring.
- Crew neck sweatshirt 2-3 sizes larger than you normally wear - DO NOT PRE-WASH – color to compliment your fabric selections. Larger is better you can always cut down to fit better.
- 1/3-1/2 yard fabric for binding
- Thread for piecing
- Thread for quilting – I used 40wt cotton for a thicker quilted look
- 1/4" piecing foot
- 1/4" seam guide (helpful but not required)
- Walking foot (not necessary if your machine has dual feed)
- Good Scissors (for sweatshirt de-construction)
- Pressing Spray (Best Press or Flatter)
- Quilters Select Free Fuse
- Quilters Clips or Pins
- Frixon Pen or Sewline Marking Pencil
- Rulers – Bring your favorite method rulers for Flying Geese and Half Square Triangles – my preference are the Quilt in a Day Rulers.
- Seam Roller – Optional but very helpful
- Appliqué Press Sheet – LARGE
- General Sewing supplies
- Machine oiled, good working condition, cord, presser feet, foot pedal
- UNIVERSIAL NEEDLES – size 90/14
