

## **A ROW OF TULIPS SERGER CLASS**

Make this 3-dimensional hanging using your serger's flatlock and rolled hem stitches

### **SUPPLIES FOR A ROW OF TULIPS**

Book – Serge & Merge Quilts by Sharon V. Rotz (We know that it's out of print but you may already have it or can find an inexpensive one on line or in a used book store ----don't spend a lot for the book because we'll get a copy of instructions for you)

I will let you do either the Down the Pathway (tulips) or Simply Leafy

½ yard background fabric

5/8 yard medium/dark green for leaves, stems, binding, borders

1/8 yard for bottom border, optional

Variegated green/purple polyester thread for background and leaves

2 spools medium/light green polyester thread for background and leaves

Variegated thread for tulips

Invisible thread for quilting later

24" X 40" batting

2/3 yard fusible backed web

Seam sealant (Fray Check or Fray Block)

Regular serger tools – tweezers, needle threader, etc.

Fabrics for the pieced section

Fabrics for the leaves and stems

Large-eyed needle for the yarn insertion
