

**CITRUS CRUSH:** Choose to make either Citrus Crush or another Hoop Sister's table topper of your choice. You will purchase your design at Becky's if you make Citrus Crush; all other designs will be downloaded directly from Hoop Sisters – access their site through our website. Let me know before class if you are doing a different design.

**SUPPLY LIST FOR CITRUS CRUSH:**

Design USB from Becky's

Choose 5 inch or 8 inch size

Print out all directions including fabric requirements; see page 2 for fabric placement and block set to help understand the supply list pages 3 & 4. Once your fabrics pieces are cut be sure to have them labeled by block identification.

Battilizer OR Poly Mesh and batting

Hoop size based on block size

Pinking shears to trim when finished

New machine needle size 75/80

Bobbin filled with Bottom Line bobbin thread

Threads to match each fabric

Vanish Lite water soluble thread

Double curved scissors

If using my method for polymesh/batting cut your batting:

A1 (4)  $5\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$  or  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$

A2 (4)  $5\frac{1}{2} \times 5$  or  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 8$

B1 (4)  $5\frac{1}{2} \times 5$  or  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 8$

B2 (4)  $4\frac{7}{8} \times 4\frac{7}{8}$  or  $7\frac{3}{4} \times 7\frac{3}{4}$

Just a side note: I backed my fabrics with Heat and Bond Lite. If I had been using a batik fabric I would not have done that. I know this makes the project a bit heavier but I do not like the fussy edges that are left when cutting plain cotton quilt fabrics and leaving raw edges exposed. Your choice!
