This workshop is a total of two days. The project can be completed during those two days. Students will learn and use Claudia's multi-hooping technique for 100% Perfect Placement. Claudia has several you tube videos to help with our process.

Students should expect to learn:

- Master your embroidery machine
- Improve hooping skills
- Rotate designs for precision placement
- "Sew through a design" without thread
- Tips and techniques to make your project flat, fun, and flawless.

Finished Size:

- 15 ½ " x 45"
- Minimum Hoop Size – 8" x 12" (Maxi Hoop) Clamp Hoop will work for individual pumpkins
