

FALL WALL HANGING / TABLE TOPPER

Choose either Falling Leaves wall hanging or the Fall Table Topper from HoopSisters.

Print out all of their instructions which include a detailed supply list for fabrics and threads.

If you do not want to use Battilizer as your stabilizer, I will show you how I use PolyMesh and batting.

For the table topper, you will need a hoop that will hold a 5-inch block for most of the parts; note you will also need a 5" X 10" or a 6" X 6" for the outside large points.

For the wall hanging I think you will need the Maxi or Mega hoop

Thread – water soluble (optional), neutral color for piecing and quilting thread as they suggest.

Bobbin filled with Bottom Line

Double curved scissors

Glue stick is helpful.

Thread clips

Have all of your fabrics pre-cut & labeled before coming to class based on their cutting instructions; don't cut backing and optional piping.

Table topper, if you are using batting, not Battilizer, cut 12 – 5 ½" squares, 4 – 6 ¼" squares and 2 – 9" squares cut diagonally, or you could just cut 18 – 6-inch squares of batting.

Wall hanging, if you are not using Battilizer, I will need to check your pattern and then I can tell you exactly what size to cut your batting. I can suggest you cut the pieces the size given for wool batt, but you will be working with pieces that just fit within the stitching lines and if that is too close for you, then a bit larger. You will also need to calculate which blocks need batting in the outer edges for the binding so maybe just wait for my help.
