CHICKEN & QUILT BLOCKS Supply List

Fabric for Blocks:

Nine - 5 ½" squares for the background (you will be stitching the designs on this fabric)
18 - 3" squares, cut diagonally to produce 36 triangles (Note: the book calls for 2 7/8" squares.
An update on the website www.pieceinthehoop.com suggested using 3" squares)

Fabric for Borders:

Two - 3 ½" x 16" strips Two - 3 ½" x 24" strips

Fabric for Backing:

One - 26" square

Fabric for binding:

One strip, 5 ½" x 40"

Batting:

One - 26" square

Stabilizer:

The book recommends Floriani No Show Mesh Fusible stabilizer because it eliminates the need for a temporary spray adhesive. If you have that, that is fine. A small craft iron is then needed to fuse the fabric to the stabilizer, right in the hoop.

I used a polymesh cut-away stabilizer and blue painter's tape to hold material in place. You could also use a tear-away stabilizer.

Also:

Thread - Neutral thread for piecing

Embroidery thread for bluework (or choose your own color to match or contrast with your fabric). If you want a more hand-stitched look, use a cotton thread.

Hoop that is at least 5" x 7"

Embroidery designs: (From CD included with book) To locate the designs, put disc in your computer. Click **START**, then **COMPUTER**. Locate the drive that your disc is in and double click. Click the file that says **Embroidery Patterns**. Your format will now appear in a folder. Copy these to your USB stick.
