

Exploring Applique

We will be stitching out the project from the Bernina Club Lifestyles webcast this month. If you can do some preparations before class, you will probably be able to complete the project during class time.

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing machine
- Reverse pattern foot #1/1C/1D
- Open Embroidery foot #20/20C/20D
- Invisible zipper foot #35
- Zipper foot #4/4D or bulky overlock foot #12C

Fabrics and Notions:

- 22 inches 45" fabric for pillow cut into 2 – 21" squares
- ¼ yard fabric for applique
- 1 yard Trans-web (this should be applied to the back of the applique fabric & then trace the frame 5 times)
- Titanium needles size 90 or smaller, dependent on fabric weight
- Invisible zipper 14-16"
- Pillow form 20"
- Light weight fusible tear-away stabilizer
- Rotary cutters, regular and small
- 5 inch scissors
- Marking tools and ruler

Threads:

- Isacord or embroidery thread of your choice to coordinate with fabric
- Embroidery bobbin thread
- Construction thread

Before Class:

Cut pillow fabric out ~ Back applique fabric with the Trans-web ~ Design traced onto your applique fabric and cut out

If you aren't comfortable cutting out the applique, that could wait until class time, but you may get as far as other attendees.

Class Policy:

Please bring all items on supply list or be prepared to purchase them. Please arrive 10 minutes prior to class time to set-up. All prep specified on supply list is to be done ahead of time.
