

Free-motion Machine Quilting With a Stitch Regulator (BSR)

You will get the most out of this class if:

1. Your machine has a stitch regulator and you have at least a little experience with using it, or
2. If you don't have a stitch regulator, you feel confident to free-motion quilt at least a basic stipple or meandering stitch.

Supply List

Sewing machine in good working order that has free-motion quilting capabilities.

Stitch regulator for your machine (a BSR, if it's a Bernina), or a darning or embroidery foot

Basic sewing supplies

Gloves for machine quilting, such as Machingers

Plain paper and pencil (for practice drawing designs before quilting them), at least 12 sheets

Muslin or other solid, light-colored fabric, cut into 20-inch squares. Please bring (4) four squares, that you will make into two quilt sandwiches.

Batting, the thinner the better, two 20-inch squares

Thread, color(s) that will show up well on the muslin or fabric of your choice

Needles of various sizes, such as a 90/14, 80/12, 70/10

Fabric marker, such as a blue water-soluble marker, for marking segments on your sampler (or you could use a pencil instead)

Ruler, 18 to 24 inches long, for marking segments

Walking foot, if you own one
