SUPPLIES: Start Quilting book available at Becky's Fabric, rotary cutter, sewing machine in good working order (bring your instruction book), blue painter tape-any width, basic sewing supplies-scissors, pins and the like, rotary cutting guide-6" x 12", thread-I recommend Mettler, Microtex needles for your machine, ¼" presser foot if you have one and any other tools that you usually use.

FABRICS: As listed in the pattern, pre-washed and batting as listed in the pattern.

Bring along a sack lunch.
