

PAPER PIECING PROJECT

Go to www.mhquilt designs.com to choose and purchase your pattern for this class. If you have never done paper piecing before, be sure to choose a design with fewer pieces; in other words do NOT choose a design like the barn sample which has the very small pieces for the fence and windmill.

BEFORE class, please trace your pattern pieces onto Stitch and Ditch paper using a soft lead pencil and ruler to be sure that your lines are accurate and straight. Also, if the pattern suggests, cut your chosen fabrics into pieces.

SUPPLIES:

Sewing machine

foot control

power cord

Fabric requirements will be listed in your pattern

Soft lead pencil and small ruler

Stitch and Ditch paper for tracing your pattern pieces BEFORE class – available at Becky's

Fabrics

Needle -- #70 universal

Neutral colored thread such as Mettler Silk Finish #813

Small hole throat plate for machine, optional

¼" Machine foot -- #37, 57, 97 – your choice

Small iron and pressing pad

Small, sharp scissors and/or small rotary cutter with small cutting mat

Class Policy:
