

SIMPLY LEAFY SERGER PROJECT

“Serge & Merge Quilts” by Sharon V. Rotz

Supplies as listed in project, page 66

Also, please have your fabrics cut as suggested (the white and the brown 2” strips are what they use for binding – I like 2.5 inch piece instead)

To finish your project, you will also need a backing and a piece of batting

Serger – if you do not have a Bernina be sure to bring your book and all of your attachment/parts

For a Bernina, bring the 2 thread converter piece – that little black cap with attached wire that fits in the cover accessory case

Scraps of fabrics for testing before beginning project

Scissors and rotary cutter

Blunt needle and light weight yarn

Threads – I used a variegated for one thread for flat locking

Sewing machine will be needed for quilting, stitching down the stems & leaves --- this may not get finished in class; we will do all the flat locking and the serger piecing first. You need thread for the flat locking, for piecing, and for stitching the edges of the stems

Very sharp small scissors

Bamboo point turner

¼ inch Steam A Seam Lite 2
