## SQUARE IN A SQUARE

The plan is that you will use the Square in A Square blocks to make the basic piece; then you will add designs of your choosing for some of the blocks. The designs I used are included on the CD if you like these designs. You have your choice of size - 5 inch or 8 inch blocks. You are also free to arrange these in any way you desire and make as small a piece or as large as you want. Because of this, it will be hard to list yardages; you will need to do some of your own calculations.

## SUPPLIES

Design CD available at Becky's. It's from Hoop Sisters and for use by most machines Hoop size depends on size choice - 5 inch block or 8 inch block

Poly Mesh stabilizer
Batting - I used Battilizer; cut the squares before coming to class so that they are $1 / 2$ inch larger than you block size
*Embroidery threads of your choice
Bobbins filled with bobbin thread

Double curved scissors
Basic fabric requirements per block:
Center fabric of each block (fabric 1)

8 \text { inch }-61 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 4^{\prime \prime} \quad 5 \text { inch }-41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime}
$$

Corners (half square tringles) (Fabric 2)

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8 \text { Inch }-53 / 4 \text { " squares } \quad 5 \text { inch }-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \text { squares }
$$

Borders - based on what you are making
*Note: If you use the designs Prairie Chic from the CD, please have your color way and threads chosen before coming to class so that you can begin stitching right away. I sort of followed their suggestions but based my colors on my fabric, not their colors.
