

SQUARE IN A SQUARE

The plan is that you will use the Square in A Square blocks to make the basic piece; then you will add designs of your choosing for some of the blocks. The designs I used are included on the CD if you like these designs. You have your choice of size – 5 inch or 8 inch blocks. You are also free to arrange these in any way you desire and make as small a piece or as large as you want. Because of this, it will be hard to list yardages; you will need to do some of your own calculations.

SUPPLIES

Design CD available at Becky's. It's from Hoop Sisters and for use by most machines

Hoop size depends on size choice – 5 inch block or 8 inch block

Poly Mesh stabilizer

Batting – I used Battilizer; cut the squares before coming to class so that they are ½ inch larger than your block size

*Embroidery threads of your choice

Bobbins filled with bobbin thread

Double curved scissors

Basic fabric requirements per block:

Center fabric of each block (fabric 1)

8 inch – 6 ¼" X 6 1/4"

5 inch – 4 ¼" X 4 ¼"

Corners (half square tringles) (Fabric 2)

8 Inch – 5 ¾" squares

5 inch – 3 ½" squares

Borders – based on what you are making

*Note: If you use the designs Prairie Chic from the CD, please have your color way and threads chosen before coming to class so that you can begin stitching right away. I sort of followed their suggestions but based my colors on my fabric, not their colors.
