

YOU AND ME

This class is designed for the person who is comfortable with embroidery and has a grandchild or friend who would like to experience what you enjoy about the world of embroidery. You will be the “helper” who sits close by and helps as needed i.e. shows them how to thread the machine, how to access an embroidery design, etc. **You are NOT to do the work for them!!!!**

I would like the two of you to choose a simple project/embroidery to do in the class. I suggest a design from Embroidery on Line or Sarah Vedeler as these are quality designs with good results. Project ideas might be a simple zipper bag, an iPad holder, a tote bag etc. It would be best if the embroidery and the project could be completed in one day.

DAY TWO:

Today we will make one or two zipper bags using commercial food/snack bags so begin to look for your/their favorite snack so you can purchase it before coming to class. Very carefully open the bag and empty out the contents—just cut off only one end.

SUPPLIES needed:

Piece of fabric and batting the size of the bag

Thread that matches or coordinates with the snack bag

Zipper that is longer than the bag by at least 2 inches

Sewing machine with general purpose sewing foot -- 1, 1C, 1D and a zipper foot 4, 4D; seam guide to insert in back of foot

If you have the Missouri Star BLOCK volume 2, issue 4, the instructions are printed in that

Fusible Pellon vinyl; I will have some available but if you really get into making these, you may wish to purchase your own supply

Register early to guarantee your space in class.

Please bring all items on supply list or be prepared to purchase them. Please arrive 10 minutes prior to class time to set-up. All prep specified on supply list is to be done ahead of time.

Out of respect to the teachers and other students: only paid students may be in the classroom during class time. No children/pets, cell phone use or perfume allowed.
