Kimberbell Projects

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You may stitch any Kimberbell project in class, but we will feature a different Kimberbell technique each month.

Materials Needed: Cuties Jan-June Project Booklet and online purchase of quilting designs, if desired.

January Techniques: Piecing in the Hoop and Embroidered Applique
Please read cutting instructions in your desired pattern & cut as much as possible before class.

Kimberbell Quilting Designs for Cuties-purchased separately from Kimberbell
Midi or Large Oval hoop
Yellow Bobbin Case (5 and 7 Series machines)
Shapeflex (to fuse at a 45 degree angle on each background piece only)
PolyMesh Cutaway Stabilizer
Batting Stabilizer
Bobbin filled with Superior Bottom Line in a light neutral color
OESD TearAway Paper Tape

Lazy Daisy, page 20

Fabric 1: Background (4) 7½ x 7½"

Quarter-circle: (4) 2½ x 2½"

Fabric 2: Petal 1 (4) 3½ x 5"

Fabric 3: Petal 2 (4) 4 x 5"

Fabric 4: Petal 3 (4) 3½ x 5"

TRIANGLE:

Up to Snow Good, page 26

Fabric 1: Background Triangle* (2) 13 x 13"

*Sub-cut each Background square to (2) triangles (see page 42).

Fabric 2: Hat (4) 2½ x 2½"

White Applique Glitter: Snowman (4) 3 x 4"

BORDERS AND BINDING:

Sewing a Cutie Together, page 40

Fabric 1: Inner Border A (2) 1¾ x 10½"
Inner Border B (2) 1¾ x 13"

Binding (2) 2½" x WOF plus (1) 2½ x 20"

Fabric 2: Outer Border (4) 2½ x 18"

Fabric 3: Corner Blocks (4) 2½ x 2½"

Fabric 4: Back (1) 24 x 24"

Threads: As shown in project booklet-Olive Green, Lt Sage Green, Red, Yellow, Lt Grey, Charcoal, Black, White plus a color for quilting

Sewing supplies: Machine and module in cleaned and oiled working order, brush to clean your machine, machine oil, Bobbin filled with light colored Bottom Line, Ultra Clean and Tear Stabilizer for emergencies cord, Foot Control slide on table, thread, Zig Zag (9mm) Stitch Plate #9 embroidery foot, #97D ¼" foot Superior or Microtex 80/12 needles, pins, small curved sharp scissors to trim threads, seam ripper.



SUPPLY LIST AND CLASS POLICIES

1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment.
3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are required for class must be purchased to prevent copyright violations.
6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay your registration fee. This discount is for supplies for this one class and will be given through the day of class.
7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
12. Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.
13. Cell phones should be muted in classes, clubs or lectures. Please be respectful of the teacher and other students by putting phones on vibrate if you are expecting an urgent call. The store number may be left with your family for emergency calls: 443-5724.

Special Event fees are refundable with a 30 day notice.

Basic Sewing Supplies: Sewing machine in good working order, foot control, power cord, slide on table, machine needles, thread, seam ripper, small scissors for fabric, paper scissors, quilting pins, extra bobbins pre-wound, rotary cutter, cutting mat, ruler, paper & pencil
