This specific pattern was designed for the BERNINA L890 (top of the line serger), as long as your machine can stitch out Chainstitch, Coverstitch and Overlock stitches. You can join this class.

### Week 1: Elongated Tumbler Block

- o Please have ready for Class:
  - o Cut out Fabric A & B from page 14 in pattern
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 1 Spools of Gray Seracor Thread
  - o 2 different colors of decorative threads (12 weight)
    - To follow patterns:
      - 1 spool of Glamore 4141
      - 1 spool of Spagetti SP80
  - o Right Seam Guide
  - o Template Plastic 5" x 12" piece (at least)
  - o Shirring Foot #C24

## Week 2: Wonky Log Cabin Blocks

- o Please have ready for Class:
  - o Cut out fabric following pattern in page 18
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 3 Spools of White or Light Grey Seracor Thread
  - o NO DECORATIVE THREADS NEEDED
  - o Clear Standard Foot #C27

## Week 3: Flatlock Block

- o Please have ready for Class:
  - o Cut out fabrics F & O following pattern in page 23
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 2 different colors of decorative threads (12 weight)
    - To follow patterns:
      - 1 spool of Spagetti SP80
      - 1 spool of Spagetti SP44
  - o Shirring Foot #C24

## Week 4: Strip-Pieced Blocks

- o Please have ready for Class:
  - o Cut out fabrics following pattern in page 28
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 3 Spools of White or Light Grey Seracor Thread
  - o 2 different colors of decorative threads (12 weight)
    Of your choice
  - o Clear Standard Foot #C27
  - o 8 1/2" square ruler

## Week 5: Flying Geese Block & Bow-Tie Blocks

- o Please have ready for Class: for Flying Geese
  - o Cut out Fabric C & D & S from pages 9-12 in pattern
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 2 Spools of White Seracor Threads
  - o 2 different colors of decorative threads
    - To follow patterns:
      - 1 spool of Spagetti SP80
      - 1 Spool of Spagetti SP44
  - o Metal Seam Guides
  - o Clear Standard Foot #C27
- o Please have ready for Bow-Tie Blocks
  - o Cut out fabrics D, G, K, R, on page 25
- o Bring to class:
  - o 2 spools of white or light gray Seracor Threads
  - o NO DECORATIVE THREADS NEEDED
  - o Chain/Coverstitch Foot #C13 (comes with machine)

## Week 6: Leaf & Flower Rolled Hem

- o Please have ready for Class:
  - Cut out fabric H (10) 5" x 8" for leaves
    - Fuse Heat-N-Bond Lite to the wrong side of fabric
  - o Cut out Fabric B, D, G, S following pattern on page 38
    - Fuse Heat-N-Bond Lite to the wrong Side of fabric
  - Cut Flower Pot fabrics together on page 34 (will not have time to sew together in class)
- o Bring to this Class:

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
- o 2 Light Gray Seracor threads
  - 1 different colors of decorative threads (12 weight)
    - To follow patterns:
      - 1 Spool of your choice
- o Bring the Fabric for the stem (fabric: K) we will cut fabric in class
- o Curve Foot #C23
- o Template Plastic 5" x 8" rectangle -- Trace and have ready following Leaf template on page 36

#### Week 7: Leaf, Flower & Stem Sew Down


- o Please have ready for Class:
  - o Have your fabrics from Week 6 stitched with the Rolled Hem and the stem Fabric K bring to class
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 3 Spools of White or Light Grey Seracor Thread
  - o NO DECORATIVE THREADS NEEDED

- o Clear Standard Foot #C27
- o Cover/chainstitch Foot: #C13
- o Coverstitch Compensating Foot: #C12
- o Curve Foot: #C23

#### Week 8: Quilt Assemble and Quilting

- o Please have ready for Class:
  - Come with each block row ready to assemble together
    - Example on page 51
  - Have your Backing and Batting Ready for Sandwiching
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 3 Spools of White or Light Grey Seracor Thread
  - o NO DECORATIVE THREADS NEEDED
  - o Clear Standard Foot #C27
  - o Want to try Rulers:
    - You need a straight edge ruler
    - And a slight curved quilting ruler
    - Free motion quilting

#### Week 9: Binding

- o Please have ready for Class:
  - o Cut Fabric for binding I like to cut by strips 2 ¼" you will need 7 strips total of fabric E
  - Come with fabrics pieced together (you can do on serger with stitch #16 or on sewing machine)
    - And folded in half wrong sides together
- o Bring to this Class:
  - o 3 Spools of White or Light Grey Seracor Thread
  - o 1 spool of the Superior Charlotte's Web Fusible Thread
  - o NO DECORATIVE THREADS NEEDED
  - o Clear Standard Foot #C27
