



SUPPLY LIST AND CLASS POLICY

Quilted Tamarack Jacket by Grainline Studio Pattern and using Field of Seams Fabric by Judy Gauthier

Class Descriptions:

Tamarack Jacket is a warm and stylish quilted coat perfect for spring and fall layering. We will be fitting, cutting, quilting, sewing and finishing this jacket in the span of 6 days. This is a beginner's class so we will not be making pockets

PATTERN REQUIRED: TAMARACK JACKET by Grainline Studios

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS FIELD OF SEAMS - BITTERSWEET

Outside of Jacket - 2.75 yards

Inside Lining of Jacket - 3.25 yards (Lining 2.75yd and Binding 1/2yd) If you are finishing your jacket inside with a serger then you will only need 2.75 yards of fabric for lining.

Batting for between layers: 2.50 yards low loft batting I used 4 oz bamboo batting but you could also use Thermore. Your choice. You might be able to use scraps also as long as there are all the same fabric.

PRE-WASH ALL FABRICS BEFORE CLASS AND CUTTING

Other Sewing Supplies:

- Threads to match your fabrics Your choice of polyester or cotton
- Thread Snips
- Fray Check for seams if serging
- Wonder Clips
- Dressmaker Shears
- Clover Hot Hemmer
- 1/4" Patchwork foot, # 1C, D foot, and the #10C or D Edgestitch foot, #71 Binding foot
- Stiletto
- Bernina or Martelli Tweezers
- Size 90/14 or Size 80/12 Microtex sharp needles
- 3.5" x 18 1/2" Creative Grid Ruler
- Pressing mat and mini iron
- Sewing Machine - Cleaned, threaded ready for class!



FRIDAY NIGHT: Fitting and cutting No Machines this night, You need washed fabrics and batting for cutting. All your cutting essentials.

SATURDAY: Quilting the fabric and assembling

WEDNESDAY: Finish Sewing and Binding

CLASS POLICIES

1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment.
3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are requites for class most be purchases to prevent copyright violations.
6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay for registration fee. this discount is for supplies for this one class and will be given through the day of the class.
7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
12. Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.
13. Cell phones should be muted in classes, clubs or lectures. Please be respectful of the teacher and other students by putting phones on vibrate if you are expecting an urgent call step out of class.

Special Event fees are refundable with a 30 day notice.
