

In this class we will be making all three Flip and Heat Microwave Baskets. To complete three baskets, please complete the following tasks before coming to class. Come early to set up so we can start right at noon.

- ✂ Please have your three baskets cut prior to class. ½ yard of the interior body fabric and ½ yard of the exterior body fabric will make one basket of each size by using the following cutting instructions. Make sure to cut all three squares out of both fabrics.

Remaining fabrics can be used for handles  
if not using cotton strapping  
A total of 4" x 36" will be needed for all six handles

- ✂ A yard of cotton batting will make all three baskets. Do not cut your batting until class. We'll cut the batting together to show options for how to avoid waste. Written cutting instructions will be provided in the class.
- ✂ As a reminder, because these are designed for the microwave, make sure you are using cotton thread.
- ✂ For the handles, please cut and iron them prior to class. You may prefer to use COTTON strapping. If so, 1 yard will be enough strapping for all six handles. It's up to you!
- ✂ A 45-degree triangle ruler will also help mark quickly and accurately.
- ✂ Heat erasable markers are recommended.
