Skill Level: Intermediate Bag Maker

A belt bag that's perfect for everyday use. Compact and easy to wear across the front or back of the body. Great bag for travel and security. Multiple flap hardware closure options for maximum versatility. The back zippered pocket is perfect for your phone, with a spacious interior with a zippered pocket inside!

Belt Bag Approx Size: $9.5^{"}$ wide x 2" deep x 7" tall

Fabric Requirements:

- Exterior Fabric: 1/3yd or Fat quarter (Sample: Charlie Harper Deer)
- Lining Fabric: 1/2yd nondirectional OR 2/3yd directional fabric (Sample: light Brown)
- Accent Fabric (Flap) 7" x 14" recommended fabric is waxed cotton or cork (Sample: waxed cotton)
- Fusible Woven: SHAPE-FLEX (SF101) 1 3/4yd
- Zipper: at least 20" of zipper (8" back pocket & 6" inside pocket) (Sample: Sally Tomato by the yard)
- 1" wide Cotton Webbing for Strap: 1 ½ yds
- Hardware
 - Straps: >> (2) 1" wide D-rings
 - Straps: >> (10 1" wide Slider
 - Straps: >> (2) 1" wide Swivel Hooks

Belt Bag Hardware Closure options:

- 1. Leather swivel hook closure
 - a. Leather $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12"
 - b. (1) $\frac{1}{2}$ " Swivel hook
 - c. (1) ¹/₂' D-Ring
 - d. Package of Medium size Rivets & Rivets with hole punch (OESD perfect hole puncher)
- 2. Turn lock
- 3. Loxx Fastener

- Water-soluble pen/pencil
- Cutting mat
- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- Size 90/14 Denim/Jeans needle

- 8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
- 9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
- 10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
- 11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
- 12. Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.
