

# Makers Tote Supply List

Skill Level: Intermediate

This carry-all tote is for the makers, the creatives, and the go-getters. It's my spin on a classic doctor's bag, but designed with handy on-the-go storage in mind. Perfect for kids and adults alike, this tote will be sure to keep whatever you need close at hand and organized. Please make note of the recommended skill level for this particular pattern.

#### APPROX. FINISHED DIMENSIONS:

Small: 12" wide by 6" deep by 10" high

Large: 16" wide by 7.5" deep by 13" high

Makers Tote Pattern by Noodlehead

• Exterior Fabric

o 5/8 yd (½ yd)

• Lining Fabric

o 1 1/4 YD (1 yard)

Pockets Fabric

o 1 1/4 Yd (1 yard)

- Accent Fabric (includes binding, handles) ½ Yd for both sizes
- Fusible woven Inverfacing SHAPE FLEX (20" wide bolt) 1 ½ YD
- Fusible mid-weight Interfacing (44" wide) 1 yard
- byAnnie's Soft and stable OR Pellon (single sided fusible or double sided fusible)
  - ½ yard if you choose soft and stable
  - o 1 yard if you choose Pellon
- Seperating zipper (large size 18") or (Small size 14"
- 14" NONSEPERATING zipper for back pocket of tote (one for each size)
- Optional: metal snap or sew-in magnet



Recommended Fabrics: Cotton Canvas, cotton/Linen Canvas, Denim, for exterior Quilters cotton for lining and pockets.

### Additional Supplies + tools:

Polyester 50 weight fabric coordinating thread, water-soluble pen, cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter, turning tool (point turner), sewing machine needle Denim 90/14, Fabric Clips, Pinking spears, Washable fabric glue, bias tape maker 2.5" fabric width

Sewing machines Accessories: Clean and in working condition Sewing Machine, bobbins, bobbin case, power cord, foot control,

BERNINA presser feet used:

Standard foot #1 (c or D) Edgestitch foot (#10 or 10C, D), Zipper Foot (#4, D), Telfon Foot (#52 C, D)

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For Class please have ready the fabrics Cut following pattern and if any prefuzing or stabilizing that needs to be done. Make sure that is done so you can finish in class.

This project contains Bias Binding you will have to hand stitch it down at home after class. I will go over in class how to hand stitch by using a video.

- 1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
- 2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment. 3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
- 4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
- 5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are required for class must be purchased to prevent copyright violations.
- 6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay your registration fee. This discount is for supplies for this <u>one</u> class and will be given through the day of class.
- 7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
- 8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
- 9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
- 10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
- 11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
