



## SUPPLY LIST AND CLASS POLICIES

### Overlocker Skillbuilder-Baby Quilt

*Make these fun easy log cabin style blocks into a small baby quilt. This will be a fun two or three thread flatlock project with your overlocker.*

Class Date: Wednesday May 31 5-8pm

**Pattern:** Pattern provided in class by instructor.

#### **Store Products and Supplies Needed:**

**Fabrics:** You will need six fabrics to make your blocks for this baby quilt. You will need a  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of each fabric, cut into two 4" x WOF pieces for each color you will be using. Decide which fabric will be the center of your log cabin and which fabric the first piece "in the round" and cut one 4" x 4" square from each fabric.

Fray Block, four spools polyester serger thread, 80/12 Jersey Ballpoint needles, all overlocker accessories and feet, garment scissors or cutting mat & rotary cutter(if you intend to rotary cut your pattern), pins, Machine oil, bobbins, foot pedal, wonder clips, pins, slide on table, small scissors to trim threads, seam ripper.

**Extra Sewing supplies:** Overlocker cleaned, oiled and in good working order.

**Pre Class Instructions:** PREWASH YOUR FABRICS TO BE READY TO CUT IN CLASS.

Minimum class size 2, Maximum # of Students: 6



## SUPPLY LIST AND CLASS POLICIES

1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment.
3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are required for class must be purchased to prevent copyright violations.
6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay your registration fee. This discount is for supplies for this one class and will be given through the day of class.
7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
12. **Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.**
13. Cell phones should be muted in classes, clubs or lectures. Please be respectful of the teacher and other students by putting phones on vibrate if you are expecting an urgent call. The store number may be left with your family for emergency calls: 443-5724.

**Basic Sewing Supplies:** Sewing machine in good working order, foot control, power cord, slide on table, machine needles, thread, seam ripper, small scissors for fabric, paper scissors, quilting pins, extra bobbins pre-wound, rotary cutter, cutting mat, ruler, paper & pencil
