SUPPLY LIST AND CLASS POLICIES

Join us for this fun Overlocker or Sewing class making a pair of stretch pants from our Ponte Fabrics. Ponte knit is a combination of rayon, polyester and spandex. The thick, double-knit fabric provides a two-way stretch; it molds to your body shape while providing a smooth and streamlined silhouette.

High-waist (at navel), pull-on cigarette pants with concealed elastic at the waist and darts at the back.

- Inset detailing at the hip where you can use contrast fabric as a design element.
- Drafted for stable knits like ponte di roma.
- The hem should be at the ankle but vertical stretch will have an impact on the final length when you wear the pants. They might stretch out to below the ankle.

Supply List: Pattern: Jalie "Renee" pattern a front counter.

Fabric: Depending on your size, buy fabric according to the pattern recommendations. There are 28 sizes available on this pattern from girls to women. I suggest you make a traced copy of your pattern size and don't cut into the actual paper pattern. That way you can use it again for various sizes. Use the US size line on the chart and then look down under that chart to find the yardage line to find how much you need to purchase.

**Do not pre-cut your fabrics, we will do that in class. We want to fit your pattern to you before you cut. If you are totally confident and have sewn garments for yourself before you may pre-cut.

Other supplies:

Black Fantastic Elastic for waistband (In class drawer at front counter)

2 yards Red Dot Fabric for Tracing single pattern

Pins or Wonder Clips, Marking pen or pencil

4 spools "So Fine" Overlocker Thread in closest color to blend with your fabric. You could also use Isacord or the Seracor cone threads

Rotary cutter and Kai Large Scissors for garment cutting, Large Cutting mat

Overlocker or Sewing Machine in good working order. Make sure your machine is ready to sew and you know how to operate well.

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- 1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
- 2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment.
- 3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
- 4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
- 5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are required for class must be purchased to prevent copyright violations.
- 6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay your registration fee. This discount is for supplies for this one class and will be given through the day of class.
- 7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
- 8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
- 9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
- 10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
- 11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
- 12. Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.
- 13. Cell phones should be muted in classes, clubs or lectures. Please be respectful of the teacher and other students by putting phones on vibrate if you are expecting an urgent call. The store number may be left with your family for emergency calls: 443-5724.
