



## Sandhill Sling Supply List

*Sew this sling style bag to carry your daily necessities or to take for travel. It's convenient sling design allows for easy access as well as*

*being out of the way when you're not using it. It is compact yet roomy enough for the essentials.*

**FINISHED SIZE: 7" wide by 11" high by 3" deep Fabric**

### **Requirements:**

- Pattern Sandhill Sling Bag by Noodlehead
- Exterior (Recommended Fabric: Canvas or Waxed Cotton) =  $\frac{5}{8}$  yd
- Lining (Recommended Fabric: Quilters Cotton) =  $\frac{5}{8}$  yd ● Fusible Woven - Shape Flex (SF101) = 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard ● Heavy Interfacing:
  - For more structure to keep its shape use Soft & Stable (Foam):  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd (Optional)
- (1) 18" Zipper (for top pocket) ● 1.5" wide Strapping: 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  yds ● Two front pocket option:
  - Zipper Pocket:
    - 8" Zipper (or bigger)
  - Flap Pocket:
    - Sew in magnet or Luxx Snap
- Hardware:
  - 1" D-ring: Qty 1
  - 1.5" Slider; Qty 1
  - 1.5" swivel Hook: Qty 1

### **Other Sewing Materials:**

- Polyester Thread to match fabrics (ISACORD)
  - Water-soluble pen/pencil
  - Wonder tape ● Thread Snips
  - Fabric Cutters
  - Clips
  - Size 90/14 Denim/Jean needle
  - Fabric Glue
  - BERNINA Presser feet used:
    - Patchwork foot (#37,57,97), Edgestitch foot (#10), Zipper foot (#4), Teflon Foot (#52) ●
- Sewing Machine - Cleaned, threaded ready for class!



# Sandhill Sling Class Prep

## Notes for Class:

- Come to class with Basic Sewing Supplies:
  - Sewing machine in good working order with foot control, power cord, slide on table (if applicable), NEW Machine needle, Polyester Thread (Isacord or Metler), Seam Ripper, Small scissors for threads, Quilting Pins, and Extra Bobbins
- If you are using Waxed Cotton fabric for your exterior do NOT IRON Fusible interfacing. ◦ Do not iron the waxed cotton; it may melt and/or get your iron dirty.

## Prep for Class:

- It is highly suggested in order to finish the bag in class to pre-cut and pre-fuse your pieces.
  - When cutting out your pieces use the fabric labels included in pattern to label each piece
    - The labels have the name of patterns and important information on them such as size, and how many and of which fabrics to cut out.
- If you are, I liked to stabilize the bag Main body front & Back with Soft and Stable for stability. Also, if your using waxed cotton I liked using the Bosal #370 Buckram for my Back Main panel to stabilize my bag.
- I also like the bag I made when I fused Shape Flex Fusible Interfacing to all LINING Fabric Pieces.



## SUPPLY LIST AND CLASS POLICIES

1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment.
3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are required for class must be purchased to prevent copyright violations.
6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay your registration fee. This discount is for supplies for this one class and will be given through the day of class.
7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be canceled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
9. We commit to our teachers and ask for your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not canceled.
10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
12. Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.
13. Cell phones should be muted in classes, clubs or lectures. Please be respectful of the teacher and other students by putting phones on vibrate if you are expecting an urgent call. The store number may be left with your family for emergency calls: 443-5724.
