SUPPLY LIST AND CLASS POLICY

This technique has us cutting identical 60-degree triangles to make a kaleidoscopic hexagon. Terrific fun, and the results are almost always dramatic and unexpected. There are no partial or "Y" seams in this method - simple half-hex rows or columns make construction pretty easy.

Sewing Supplies

- One Block Wonder Panel Quilts Book SKU 127999
- 60 degree ruler (suggest Creative Grids SKU 102168)
- Flower head pin (.55 mm thickness SKU 103132)
- Large Mat for cutting in 1st class (suggest 24" x 18" minimum)
- Brand new rotary blade and rotary cutter
- 7 panels or the featured kit (Mountains Majesty S)
- Pack of 50 inexpensive paper plates
- Thread to match fabrics - Coordinating color
- Water-soluble pen/pencil
- Thread Snips
- Fabric scissors
- Sewing machine needle (suggest microtex 80/12)
- 1/4" presser foot
- notebook and pen



The first class you will learn how to prepare and cut your fabrics and Ann will share other tips and project with you. You do not need to bring your sewing machine to the first class. Make sure to bring rotary cutter, pins and mat.

The second class will be sewing.

1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
