T-Shirt Quilt

Enjoy a fun day cutting, stabilizing and sashing a lovely new T-Shirt Quilt. Everyone loves a memory quilt, and T-Shirts make the perfect one. Come with an idea of what size you are making because you will need lots of T-Shirts depending on the size and style.

Book Required: T-Shirt Quilts Made Easy by Martha Deleonardis (different book than previous classes).

Machine is not needed for the first session.



Store Products and Supplies Needed:

Fabrics: Fabric will be dependent on how big your quilt is going to be. It would be my recommendation to wait until class before buying any additional fabrics. You will come to class with all of your UNCUT T-Shirts that need to be cut up to make you quilt. We will cut them, stabilize them and begin to design the quilt you would like to make.

Supplies: Rotary Cutter and cutting mat, scissors for small clipping, Isacord or Aurifil thread-your choice, applique pressing sheet large, 6-10 yards of Shape flex stabilizer, variety of square rulers, depending on the sizes needed to cut shirts: 12.5" square ruler and 14" square ruler are most useful. 90/12 stretch needles, seam ripper.

Extra Sewing supplies: Sewing machine cleaned, oiled and in good working order, machine oil, bobbins, foot pedal, power cord, slide on table.

Prior to Class Instructions: Please make sure your T-Shirts are washed and clean ready to cut up for class. **We will do all the cutting in class.**

Minimum class size 4 students, Maximum # of Students: 6

1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment.
3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are required for class must be purchased to prevent copyright violations.
6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay your registration fee. This discount is for supplies for this one class and will be given through the day of class.
7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
12. **Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.**
13. Cell phones should be muted in classes, clubs or lectures. Please be respectful of the teacher and other students by putting phones on vibrate if you are expecting an urgent call. The store number may be left with your family for emergency calls: 443-5724.
