This Charming Jelly Roll project is anything but ordinary! Using pre-cuts strips, you'll create a playful design that features hearts. This is a simple beginner friendly project for your table or make bigger following the book for a throw quilt.

FINISHED SIZE: Table Runner 8" x 54" & Large 40" x 54"

1. Book: Not your typical Jelly Roll Quilt
2. 1 1/3 YD of fabric for the Hearts (light pink)
3. Binding Spool holder by Riley Blake
4. Sticker - Lips
5. Lipstick Brush cleaner
6. Valentines assortment of Bandads (never know when you may poke yourself)

Please purchase or bring the following materials before class: (for throw quilt)

- Jelly Roll for Background
- 1/3 YD Red fabric for Inner Hearts
- Backing: 3 YDS
- Batting: 49" x 62"
- Binding: 5/8 YD
- Cotton thread for piecing
- Patchwork Presser foot for machine (Bernina #37, 57, or 97)
- Thread snips
- Schmitz needles 80/12
- Pins (if needed for piecing)



Cutting Instruction for Table Runner: (8" x 54")

1. From 4 different Stips of your jelly roll
 - (1) 2.5" x 12.5" Label A
 - (1) 2" x 2" Label A
2. From 4 more Stips
 - (1) 2.5" x 6.5" Label E
 - (1) 2.5" x 2.5" Label E
 - (1) 2" x 2" Label E
3. From another 4 different strips
 - (1) 2.5" x 4.2" label B
 - (1) 2.5" x 2.5" Label B
 - (1) 2" x 2" Label B
4. From 2 different strips
 - (1) 2.5" x 12" Label F
 - (1) 2.5" x 2.5" Label F
5. From 2 strips
 - (1) 2.5" x 10"
 - (1) 2.5" x 2.5"

For White Fabric:

- Label J: (6) 4.5" x 3"
- Label K: (6) 2.5" x 2.5"
- Label L: (12) 2.5" x 2.5"
- Label N: (6) 1" x 1"
- Label M: (6) 1.5" x 1.5"

For Burgundy center heart Fabric

- Label P: (6) 2.5" x 4"

Pre-work Prior to class:

- **Please have your Fabric Cut out and labeled ready for class**

1. Registration can be made in person, online, by mail or telephone.
2. Phone reservations accepted with credit card payment.
3. Payment is required at the time of registration for class.
4. Class registration fee allows one person to attend. Please no children or visitors in class.
5. Class supply lists are available on our website. Feel free to ask us to print a supply list when you register. Books and patterns that are required for class must be purchased to prevent copyright violations.
6. The Sewing Palace would like to thank you for taking classes with us. A 15% discount is given on class supplies when you sign up and pay your registration fee. This discount is for supplies for this one class and will be given through the day of class.
7. Each class has a minimum student requirement.
8. The Sewing Palace reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class due to lack of enrollment. Every effort is made to fill the class, but if the class must be cancelled, we will notify you at least 24 hours in advance, if possible, and refund your registration fee with a store credit.
9. We commit to our teachers and ask your commitment in return. Teachers spend a lot of time preparing for classes; therefore, class fees are not refundable if you do not attend a class that is not cancelled.
10. Classes begin at the scheduled times. Please come in 15 minutes early to set up your supplies so class can start on time.
11. A limited number of classroom machines are available on a first come-first served basis. Let us know at the time of registration if you need to reserve one.
12. Please remember, respect others by not wearing perfume or scented lotions in class.
13. Cell phones should be muted in classes, clubs or lectures. Please be respectful of the teacher and other students by putting phones on vibrate if you are expecting an urgent call. The store number may be left with your family for emergency calls: 406-443-5724.
