



Technique Class Basic Quilt Making

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Learn the basics of quilting, cutting, pressing, sewing and half square triangles. This is a basic beginner class.

- Pattern: Block Book by Missouri Star (Vol 5 Issue 6)
 Early Winter 2018
- 1 package of layer cake 10" squares (Or 3 1/8 yard of on fabric)
- 2 yards background fabric (includes inner border)
- 1 yard outer border
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard binding
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler (Suggest 45mm rotary, $18" \times 24"$ mat and $6" \times 24"$ ruler by Quilters Select)
- · Sewing Machine in good working order
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot for sewing machine
- Spool of neutral cotton Aurifil thread with matching bobbin
- Bloc Loc Half Square Triangle Ruler 4.5"
- Sharp seam ripper
- Best Press Starch
- Small scissors

Sewing supplies: Your machine needs to be in good working order and you need to be comfortable and proficient using the machine. You need to know how to thread your machine and know your stitches appropriate for sewing. Machine in cleaned and oiled working order, brush to clean your machine, machine oil, bobbins, foot pedal, cord, slide on table, $\frac{1}{4}$ foot
