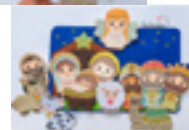

ROD TIDBIT

WHY REGULAR SERVICE IS SO IMPORTANT!

Sewing machines are precision mechanical devices. Internal components move at high speed and are aligned within very tight tolerances. Over time, lint dust, old oil, and normal wear begin to affect performance.

Regular service helps:

- Remove packed lint and debris from areas you can't access at home
- Clean and relubricate moving parts properly
- Check timing and stitch formation
- Inspect belts, gears, and tension systems for early wear
- Prevent small issues from becoming major repairs

Most machines that require expensive repairs did not fail suddenly – they gradually went out of adjustment due to lack of maintenance. Think of regular service like maintenance on a vehicle. You don't wait for the engine to fail before changing the oil. The same principles apply here. Consistent service keeps your machine sewing smoothly, extends its lifespan, and protects your investment.

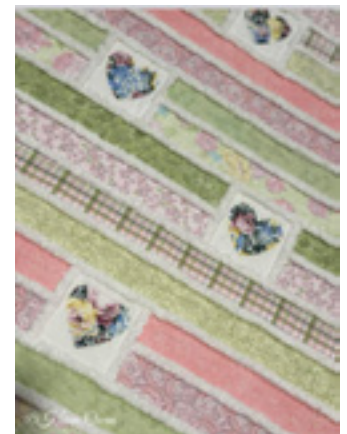
