



The feed dogs are designed to pull your fabric through at just the right place for even stitches and smooth feeding. If you try to pull or push the fabric, you can bend the needle, Throw off the machine's timing, or cause skipped stitches. Gently guide the fabric instead-your machine will thank you with straighter seams and fewer repairs down the road!
