Supply List Green Tea and Sweet Beans Beginner Needle Turn Applique

- -The book, Green Tea and Sweet Beans by Jen Kingwell
- -A variety of Background Fabrics, the largest block is 10 ½ by 20 ½.
- -Fat quarters or scraps to make flowers, leaves, basket, stars.
- -Thread to match your color fabrics, not the background.
- -Needles. Bring your favorite.
- I will give each student one of my favorites, Roxanne Applique Needles, to try.
- -Small sharp Scissors for cutting fabric.
- -Scissors for cutting template Plastic or paper.
- -Template plastic.
- -#2 Mechanical Pencil
- -White or silver marking pencil for dark fabrics (My favorite is the Clover Fine White Marking Pen...disappears when ironed)
- -Ultra Fine Sharpee Marker
- -Thimble if you use one.
- -Small Applique pins
- -"The Hole Thing" by Creative Grids used for making circles

For the first class:

We will be starting with the Orange Peel Block found on page 10. Cut a couple of 5 inch Background Squares at home

At the conclusion of these classes you will be able to make a small wall hanging similar to the class sample or you can keep going with the pieced blocks to make the complete Quilt shown in the book.
