Curbside Recycling: *What you need to know.* Brigham City will begin curbside recycling this fall. Here's a list of some items you can recycle: paper, magazines, plastic bottles and jars, food cans, party trays, aluminum foil and cans, and cardboard. The cost for curbside recycling will be dependent upon participation numbers and will range from approximately \$5.70 up to \$7.09 per month.

It is important for citizens to note that the City Council authorized an opt-out for residents if they choose not to participate. In order to opt out, you must come to City Hall and fill out a form before September 15, 2017.

Brigham City will continue with our green waste recycling program. You will still be able to bring your leaves, limbs and other green waste to the facility located at 820 North 1200 West (Watery Lane). The recycling bins at this location will, however, be removed.
