Fall is here and I hope


you all have taken a chance to get out with family and friends to enjoy the outdoor events and activities available in our community.

Leaf Collection

As fall leaf pick up season approaches, please note it is our goal to pick up leaf piles once per week in each area. This may change due to weather or work loads. Residents should pile leaves in the park strip—not in the gutter. The collection days are: Mon: west side of Main to 1200 W, south side of Forest to 1100 S; Tue: west side of Main to 1200 W, north side of Forest to 1500 N; Wed: east side of Main to 1300 E, Forest to 900 N; Thu: east side of Main to 1000 E, south side of Forest to 1100 S.

Fall Clean Up

Fall Clean Up will begin on October 15th. This will be the first extra trash day for residents whose regular collection day is Friday. Friday, November 9th is the last day of double trash pickup for those whose regular collection day is Thursday. After double trash pickup, green waste cans may be used for household garbage until spring.
