The annual **City Pride Cleanup** will begin Saturday March 30 and run through Sunday April 7, 2019. This cleanup helps residents dispose of items that are too large to put in residential containers. Items should be taken to 1650 West Forest Street between the hours of 7a.m. and 7p.m. This service is only for residents of Brigham City. No commercial dumping will be allowed AND proof of residency will be required.

**Interesting Fact:** Last year during City Pride Cleanup we collected 298 tons of debris and 4 bins of tires.

**Spring Cleanup:** Double trash pickup begins April 8 and runs through April 26, 2019. During this time residents may place their black trash cans out the day after normal trash collection day for an extra pickup during the week.



The Brigham City Community & Economic Development office issues building permits, checks zoning and planning requirements, looks into code violations, takes applications and issues business licenses, works with prospective businesses and developments, inspects new construction and remodel projects and more. All this is done by a staff of 5 full time employees and 1 part time employee.



Time to shake off the cold of winter and enjoy the beauty of Spring.




