If you need help taking items to the green waste site, please reach out to neighbors and friends for help.

This service is only for residents of Brigham City. Proof of residency will be required.

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten

The library has a new reading program for all kids under kindergarten age. The concept is simple, you read to your child with a goal of completing 1,000 books before they begin kindergarten.
